## Connecting Students to the Outdoors

K-12 students and chaperones participated in multi-day, overnight, immersive environmental and science education programs



**1,659**  
Low-income students, an estimated 40% of total participants, received financial support to fully engage and benefit from our programs and experiences



**83**  
Schools from 12 different school districts sent students to attend a total of 250 days of engaging and impactful environmental education



**\$161,525**  
Provided in scholarships for students and chaperones to attend our transformative School Program
