We spend a lot of time outside at Cal-Wood! We have a fully stocked gear room in order to make sure that all students and adults have the gear they need to be comfortable and safe outdoors.

We have warming huts and indoor spaces where we can spend time to warm up or dry off throughout the program as well!

Students will sleep in heated cabins that are separated by gender with at least 1 adult per cabin.

Our instructor team is all trained in CPR and First Aid and carry radios to be in communication with each other and the main office. Our instructors also all have college degrees, have completed background checks, and are trained in teaching the Colorado state standards in our beautiful, 1200 acre classroom!

What about wildlife?
We are fortunate enough to share our land with all kinds of wildlife - but we almost never see them! We have never had a negative wildlife encounter, and our staff are trained on how to deal with wildlife if we were to come across any.

What will they eat?
We make homemade, delicious meals at Cal-Wood, and we work to make sure that dietary restrictions and picky eaters have lots of options!
